

# Terms and Conditions

This monography, which is published as a digital platform, has been scientifically, conceptually and visually designed by Mona Tynkkinen. It is informed by the theoretical underpinnings of the project where the theoretical and methodological<sup>1</sup> contribution generates different scientific and creative content.

Mona Tynkkinen is accordingly the creator of all content that has gone into the digital platform, including texts, images, sounds, music and the (non-)methodology which has then been operationalized with the assistance of programmers into a digital system. As such, everything in this thesis, except for the source code, belongs to the intellectual and material property of Mona Tynkkinen which is published as an open access publication under the [CC BY-NC-ND 4.0](#) license<sup>2</sup>.

The technical implementation and all programming have accordingly been done by two student groups<sup>3</sup> in informatics at *University West*. The transformation of Mona's illustrations and theoretically prompted processes, such as *kaleidoscopings*, have been a realization enabled thanks to UX-designers (user experience) (begun by Isabell Hallebjörk and finalized by Markus Lamm). The continued development and finalization have been carried out by two programmers from the second group, Markus Lamm and Haashim Mohamed.

## The Digital Platform

The developed digital platform is an asp.net MVC (Active Server Pages.NET Model-View-Controller), a framework developed for building web applications. The platform is hosted on a *University West* server (da.ios.hv.se). The programming languages include Java script, HTML (HyperText Markup Language) and C#.

The rich text editor implemented into the content management system (CMS) is Jodit Editor<sup>4</sup>, an **Open Source WYSIWYG** editor written in **TypeScript**, provided an interface where Mona Tynkkinen has been able to import and manage all texts, images, sounds, videos and texts.
